The purpose of the American Red Cross Recertification Lifeguard Course is to refresh, demonstrate, and improve on the lifeguard skills that were taught and evaluated in previous lifeguard training.

Pre-Course Requirements: Ability to swim 300 yards (12 pool lengths) continuously using front crawl or breaststroke, tread water for 2 minutes, and retrieve a 10lb brick for a depth of 10 feet.

Prior American Red Cross Lifeguard Training and Certification.

You are required to have a Whistle on a Lanyard, Hip Pack and CPR Mask for Class. These items can be purchased for \$10 each at D.W. Wilson Front Desk if yours is lost or damaged.

You are required to participate in all skill sessions/drills, activities and scenarios, demonstrate competency in all required skills and scenarios, and pass the final written exam with a minimum grade of 80 percent to successfully complete the course.

Upon successful completion of the course, you will receive an American Red Cross Certificate for the Lifeguarding & First Aid/CPR/AED, valid for 2 years.
